

City Council Minutes July 25, 2016 ~ 5:00PM Special Meeting City Hall, Delta Junction, Alaska

A special meeting of the Delta Junction City Council was held on Monday, July 25, 2016 at City Hall. Mayor Pete Hallgren called the meeting to order at 5:00pm.

City Council members present: Mayor Pete Hallgren, Mayor Pro tem JW Musgrove, Lou Heinbockel

Sebastian Saarloos, Freda Degnan, William Brennan (arrived at 5:01pm)

City Council member excused: Audrey Brown

City employees present: City Administrator Mary Leith, City Clerk Pat White

One member from the community was present.

Award Crew Cab Pickup Truck

<u>Heinbockel</u> moved to award the bid for the crew cab pickup truck to Cal Worthington Ford in the amount of \$35,494.75 plus \$470.00 for a rear vision camera, \$599.00 for a complete winterization package, and \$278.00 for four extra keys, totaling \$36,841.75; Saarloos seconded.

Hallgren reported sealed bids were received from Cal Worthington Ford in Anchorage (\$35,494.75) and Seekins Ford in Fairbanks (\$38,746.30). City Attorney Jim DeWitt requested clarification from Cal Worthington Ford, the apparent low bidder, per City Code of Ordinances and written bid specs. Their bid came with a 90L Power Equipment Group option, which included power windows. Delivery would be in August, whereas Seekins Ford delivery was 90 to 120 days. Discussion followed regarding the expense of renting a work truck (\$1,695/month), the spray-in bed liner extending delivery by one week, Brennan recommending rubber floor mats, and whether it was necessary to price them out. Hallgren moved to amend the motion to add \$250.00 to purchase Weather Tech mats; Saarloos seconded. Motion passed (to add floor mats) on a roll call vote with six in attendance (Heinbockel, Brennan, Saarloos, Degnan, Musgrove, Hallgren).

Discussion followed regarding Brennan's suggestion to implement a policy about responsibilities in backing up vehicles due to no back window defogger while making changes to the *Employee Policy* (no smoking in City-owned vehicles and establishing zero tolerance for drug use).

Motion passed (to award to Cal Worthington Ford in the amount of \$37,091.75) on a roll call vote with six in attendance (Musgrove, Degnan, Saarloos, Heinbockel, Brennan, Hallgren).

ADJOURNMENT

Saarloos moved to adjourn at 5:14pm; Musgrove seconded. Motion carried.
