CANDIDATE FILING PERIOD

The candidate filing period for the October 6, 2020 Municipal Election is August 27 through the close of business on September 11. Two three-year seats will be on the ballot. Candidate filing packets are available at City Hall.

Candidates must be qualified voters and residents of the City for a period of not less than one year prior to the date of filing a nominating petition.

A qualified voter must meet the following criteria:

- citizen of the United States
- 18 years old or older
- resident of the State and of the Municipality for at least thirty (30) days preceding the election
- not registered to vote in another jurisdiction
- not disqualified under the State Constitution, or if disqualified, has had his/her rights restored

LAST DAY TO REGISTER TO VOTE

State law requires 30 days prior to an election to register to vote. State of Alaska voter registration applications are available at City Hall, DMV, or online (elections.alaska.gov) and must be postmarked or faxed (907-451-2832) before September 6, 2020 to be eligible to vote in the October 6, 2020 Municipal Election.

MAKE YOUR VOTE COUNT

Qualified voters who cannot vote at the polls on October 6, 2020 can apply for an absentee ballot (April 6 through Sept. 25), vote in person (Sept. 25 through Oct. 5), or vote by personal representative (Sept. 25 through 8:00pm, Oct. 6). Contact staff at City Hall (895-4656) for more information.
