2020 Census - Everyone in the United States gets counted every ten years. Census participation affects federal funding for education, health care, firefighting, etc. and the number of seats each state has in the U.S. House of Representatives. Surveys will be delivered to each household starting in mid-March. Response can be by mail, phone, or Internet. Library staff will assist online responders. Starting the end of May, enumerators will knock on doors of every home that has not responded. Don't delay obtaining a federally-approved ID before October 1, 2020

Driver's licenses will no longer be accepted ID to access federal buildings, military installations, or TSA checkpoints for domestic travel.

Passport books meet October mandates, plus international travel via land, sea, or air.

Passport cards meet October mandates, plus border crossings, but not international air travel.

Real ID cards meet October mandates, but not any international travel.
