City Code of Ordinances §2.30.050(a) - A defeated candidate or any ten qualified voters may contest the election of any person upon one or more of the following: 1) Malconduct, fraud or corruption of an Election Official sufficient to change the results of the election; 2) Disqualification of the person under provision of law or ordinance; or 3) Existence of a corrupt election practice as defined by the laws of the State sufficient to change the results of the election.

City Code of Ordinances §2.30.050(b) - The defeated candidate or one or more of the voters initiating a contest shall appear before the Council at the meeting held to certify the election returns (October 12, 2021) and there shall deliver a written notice of contest, or such written notice shall be filed with the City Clerk no later than 5:00pm on the Monday following the election (October 11, 2021). The notice of contest shall specify the election being contested, state the grounds of the contest in detail, and bear the notarized signatures of the candidate or the qualified voters bringing the contest.
