Three seats are on the ballot in the 2022 Delta Junction Municipal Election. Each seat has a three-year term, ending in 2025.

**Stormie Mitchell and Pamela Rawson are running for Seat B  
Lou Heinbockel and Igor Zaremba are running for Seat D  
Mary Leith and Travis Riesner are running for Seat G**

Write-in candidates are eligible for city office if: a) they are a qualified voter within the city limits and b) a resident of the city for a period of not less than one year prior to the date of taking office.

A person is qualified to vote who: a) is a citizen of the United States; b) has passed their 18th birthday; c) has been a resident of the City of Delta Junction for at least 30 days preceding the election; d) has registered to vote 30 days before the election and is not registered in another jurisdiction; and e) is not disqualified under Article V of the State Constitution.

Application for absentee voting can be requested by mail or fax between April 4 and September 24, but ballots cannot be mailed to addresses within the City limits. Ballots must be postmarked by midnight October 4 and received no later than October 14, 2022.

A qualified voter can vote early in person between September 23 and October 3, 2022.

Voters with disabilities who are unable to go to the polling place may vote through a personal representative.
