

CITY OF DELTA JUNCTION REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION District 36 – Precinct 050

8:00AM to 8:00PM Tuesday, October 3, 2023 Community Center (2287 Deborah Street)

Two seats are on the ballot in the 2023 Delta Junction Municipal Election. Each seat has a three-year term, ending in 2026.

Incumbent Michael Prestegard is running for Seat C Incumbent Pete Hallgren is running for Seat F

Write-in candidates are eligible for city office if: a) they are a qualified voter within the city limits and b) a resident of the city for a period of not less than one year prior to the date of taking office.

A person is qualified to vote who: a) is a citizen of the United States; b) has passed their 18th birthday; c) has been a resident of the City of Delta Junction for at least 30 days preceding the election; d) has registered to vote 30 days before the election and is not registered in another jurisdiction; and e) is not disqualified under Article V of the State Constitution.

Application for absentee voting can be requested by mail or fax between April 3 and September 23, 2023 but ballots cannot be mailed to addresses within the City limits. Ballots must be postmarked by October 3 and received by 3:00pm, October 6, 2023.

A qualified voter can vote early in person between September 22 and October 2, 2023.

Voters with disabilities who are unable to go to the polling place may vote through a personal representative.
