

**State of Alaska General Elections**  
**November 5, 2024, 7:00am-8:00pm**  
**Community Center (2287 Deborah Street)**

- The last day to register to vote in the November 5 General Election is Sunday, October 6. Voters can register through Division of Elections (DOE) offices, City Hall, Division of Motor Vehicles (DMV), or online ([voterregistration.alaska.gov](http://voterregistration.alaska.gov)).
- Federal law permits registration as late as Election Day for the presidential and vice-presidential race, but only that part of the ballot counts.
- October 26 is the last day to apply for a by-mail absentee ballot. Absentee ballot applications are available at DOE offices, City Hall, DMV, or online ([absenteeballotapplication.alaska.gov](http://absenteeballotapplication.alaska.gov)). Mailing of absentee ballots begins October 11, 2024.
- Early voting is available locally at City Hall two weeks prior to November 5 on Tuesdays and Thursdays, October 22, 24, 29, and 31, 12:00-7:00pm.
- Delta Junction and Rural Deltana are part of House District 36, Judicial District 4.
- Sample ballots and informational election pamphlets are available online ([elections.alaska.gov](http://elections.alaska.gov)).
- Rank Choice Voting requires filling in one oval per candidate, in each column. Ballots count even if only one candidate is ranked.
- General Election ballots will be tallied by ranked choice 15 days after November 5 *if needed*; only if the first-choice candidate does not get 50%-plus-one votes *in Alaska*.
