The local governing body(ies) will have 60 days to protest the renewal of your license.

Your application will be scheduled for the **April 8<sup>th</sup>, 2025, Special board meeting** for Alcoholic Beverage Control Board consideration. The address and call-in number for the meeting will be posted on our home

page. The board will not grant or deny your application at the meeting unless your local government waives its right to protest per AS 04.11.480(a).

**Dear Local Government:**

We have received completed renewal applications for the above listed licenses within your jurisdiction. This is the notice required under AS 04.11.480. A local governing body may protest the issuance, renewal, relocation, or transfer to another person of a license with one or more endorsement, or issuance of an endorsement by sending the director and the applicant a protest and the reasons for the protest in a clear and concise statement within 60 days of the date of the notice of filing of the application. A protest received after the 60-day period may not be accepted by the board, and no event may a protest cause the board to reconsider an approved renewal, relocation, or transfer.

To protest any application(s) referenced above, please submit your written protest for each within 60 days to AMCO and provide proof of service upon the applicant and proof that the applicant has had reasonable opportunity to defend the application before the meeting of the local governing body.

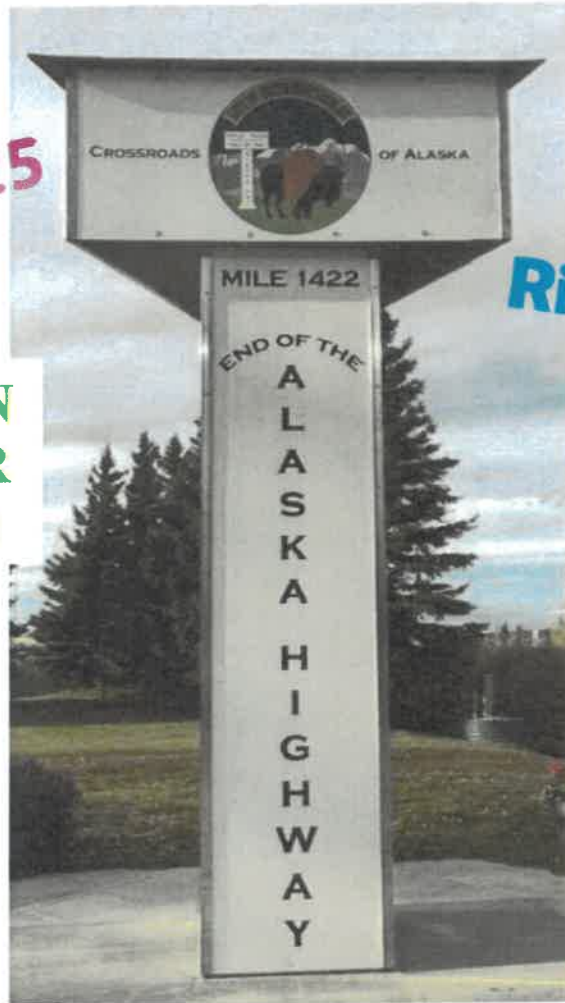

Good morning.

I am writing concerning the application for a marijuana retail shop to be opened just outside of Delta Junction. It is my understanding that while the community of Delta Junction has voted against allowing marijuana sale; there are regulations allowing for this as long as it is far enough away from the city limits.

The posted notice; however, states that we are to write to our local government to express our views. As a life-long advocate for children and former school district employee, I must state that I am against the opening of a marijuana retail shop anywhere within the Delta/Greely School District Boundaries.

My objection to the business has little to do with my personal feelings about marijuana use and much more to do with the creation of greater access to the drug by persons under the legal age of 21. Marijuana use is illegal to this population for a reason. The decision to use drugs/alcohol is one that is best left until the brain has developed to the point of being able to make logical executive decisions at this level. Brain research is clear that this does not occur until we are in our early 20s.

Not only are these young people unable to make good decisions, their brains are also less able to handle the effects of marijuana on their decision-making while under the influence of the drug.

I recognize that the laws attempt to keep marijuana out of the hands of by making its use/possession illegal until age 21.
